Location and Timing of Course

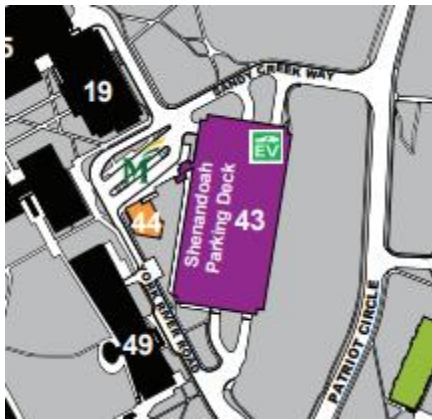
► EXPLORATORY HALL Room L502 – GEORGE MASON UNIVERSITY – Fairfax Campus
